Imagine if a little girl you love—maybe even your own daughter—were horribly burned in an accident. Now, imagine if there were no hospital nearby.

This was reality for Naomi Desai from Les Cayes, Haiti. Her seven-year-old daughter Taina was burned over 30% of her body when an oil lamp fell on her. Naomi frantically tried to find a hospital for her daughter. They visited five different medical centers, traveling more than six hours from their home.

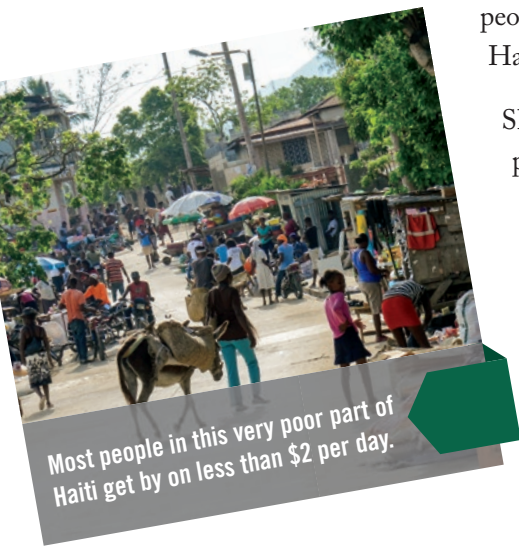
**No hospital would help Taina.** Some insisted on huge payments up front, which Naomi couldn't afford. Others were simply not equipped to deal with the severity of Taina's injuries. Mother and daughter were turned away time and again. **Until they came to St. Boniface Hospital.**



I know that, as someone deeply committed to ending suffering and ensuring dignity for people around the world, you will be inspired by the work happening at the St. Boniface Haiti Foundation every day.

SBHF provides high-quality healthcare for some of the poorest and most vulnerable people in the world, and we do it with compassion and love regardless of the patient's ability to pay. For 30 years, SBHF has been working in southern Haiti where most people live on less than \$2 a day.

What started as a one-room clinic has grown into a 124-bed hospital which is now a model for providing quality care in poor and remote places. St. Boniface Hospital serves over 100,000 patients per year, and SBHF's Community Health team reached over 34,000 people in 2017 alone. SBHF is the largest and best health care provider for 2.3 million people in southern Haiti. But we need your help to ensure that all people can have access to care.

Now, Taina is home, ready to go back to school and back to being a happy, healthy seven-year-old.

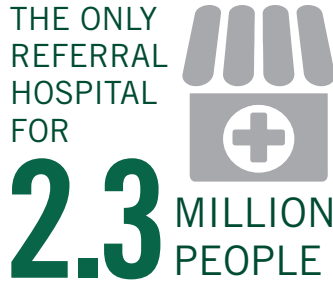
## OUR MISSION

### PATIENTS ANNUALLY

SBHF's staff of close to 350 (98% of whom are Haitian) see over 8,000 patients every month. And that number is growing every day.



SBHF supports the only major referral hospital on Haiti's southern peninsula that provides care—including NICU and surgical services—to everyone, regardless of their ability to pay.



Providing vaccinations, malnutrition screenings, maternal health monitoring, and basic primary care across an extremely remote, mountainous area.

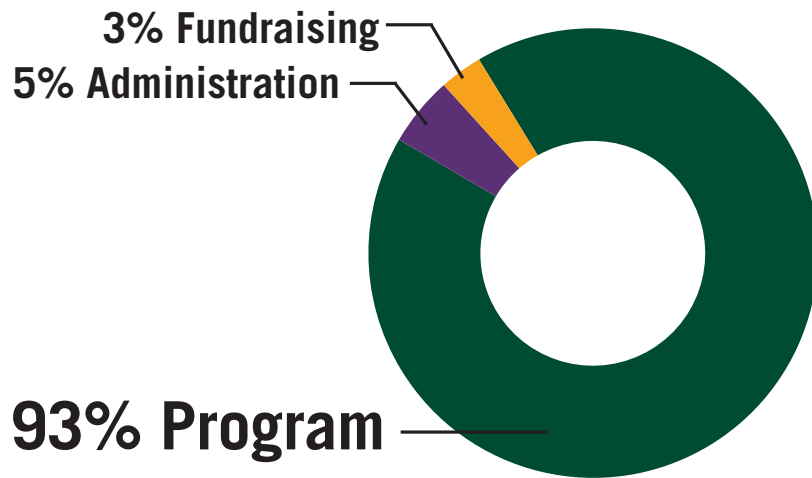
