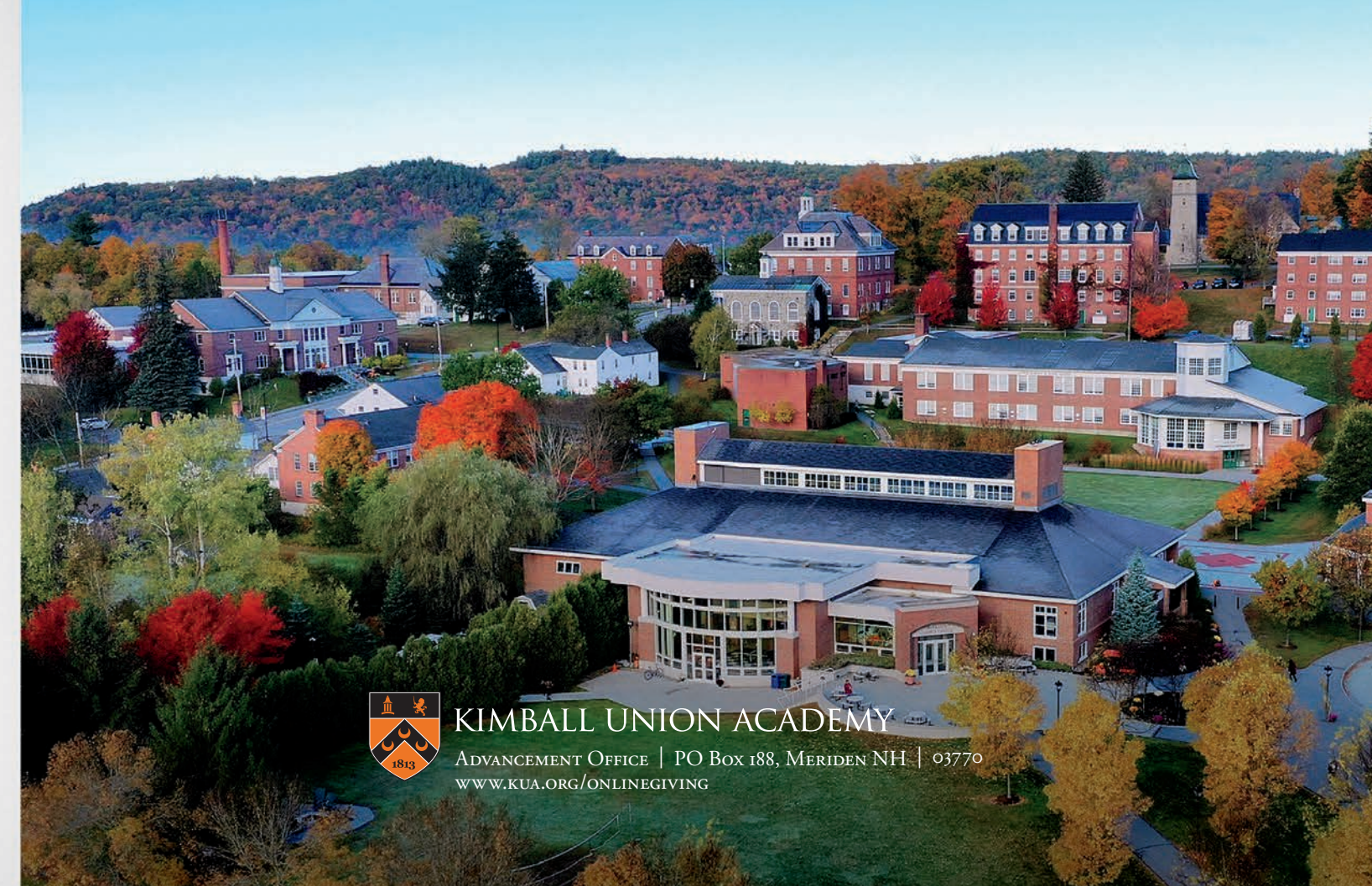

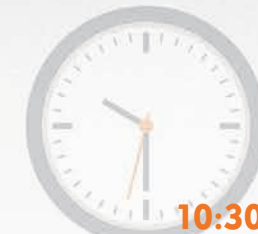
8:25 AM
