
## **2019 Highlights**

- The Charles Hayden Planetarium celebrated its 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary.
- The Museum entered a partnership with DCF to allow foster children and families free admission to the Museum through the Wonderfund.
- A three-year fundraising effort concluded with 23.5 million raised in initial support for the Blue Wing transformation.
- Governor Charlie Baker kicked-off the second annual Massachusetts STEM Week at the Museum, a statewide effort to increase awareness, interest, and ability for all learners to see themselves in STEM education and professional opportunities.
